A COMPLETE shutdown of operation at the BPCL Liquid Cargo jetty, at JN Port, has been scheduled from April 8 to April 12, 2025 to facilitate the Pipeline Trestle Strengthening Project. During this period, critical activities such as cutting, welding and grinding will take place at the jetty.
