V.O. Chidambaranar Port celebrates 76th Republic Day with grandeur

CHIDAMBARANAR Port grandly celebrated the 76th Republic Day at Port's School ground on 26th January 2025 with Mr Susanta Kumar Purohit, IRSEE, Chairperson, unfurling the National flag and taking the salute from the contingent of CISF. Port Fire Service and Port School's NCC cadets, according to a release.

In his Republic Day message, the Chairperson highlighted the significance of 26th January, marking the birth of the Indian Republic with the adoption of the Constitution. He acknowledged the wisdom and care of India's founding fathers, who guided the nation through its struggles.

Sharing the recent developments at the Port, Mr Susanta Kumar Purohit said that the North Cargo Berth-III at the Port will be dredged by February 2025 to accommodate vessels with a draft of up to 14.20 metres. He also shared that V.O. Chidambaranar Port has been identified as an "Offshore Wind Energy Hub" by the Government of India. To support this initiative, the Port is constructing an exclusive terminal with two berths for handling heavy-duty windmill blades and accessories, which will contribute to the generation of 20 GW of wind power along the Tamil Nadu coastline.

Chairperson affirmed

that with the Government of India's push for a \$5 trillion economy, the upcoming significant developments in Tuticorin's hinterland - including the Green Hydrogen hub, Offshore Wind Energy hub, port-based industries, Solar Power farms, and the industries along the Chennai-Kanyakumari Industrial Corridor-VOC Port is poised for significant growth in container traffic, reaching around 4 to 5 million TEUs within the next 3 to 5 years.

As part of the celebration, the Chairperson, distributed the Traffic Performance Awards for the year 2022-23 for exemplary performance of Steamer Agents, Stevedores, Container Vessel Operators, Container Container Liners. Freight Stations. Custom House Agents. Exporters, Importers and Business Partners. He distributed the Meritorious Awards to the officers and staff of various Departments of the Port.
