On February 3, 2026, the terminal achieved its highest ever single day cargo handling performance of 37,783 metric tonnes (MT) of Slab and Fertilizer.

A standout moment from this record: 20,600 MT was discharged from the *MV GH Glory*, surpassing the previous daily record of 17,716 MT set by the *MV African Baza* on November 22, 2022.

## Priority berthing at Mumbai Port for vessels carrying LPG

NEW DELHI/MUMBAI, March 12

THE Union Ministry of Ports, Shipping & Waterways (MoPSW) has announced that vessels carrying LPG will receive priority berthing at Mumbai Port on payment of charges as per the Scale of Rates. The measure takes effect immediately and will remain in place until further notice, as per Mumbai Port Authority Trade Notice No. TM/LPG Priority Berthing/52.
